

# FLETCHER LAKE COMMISSION

May 2018

A FORMAL meeting of the FLETCHER LAKE COMMISSION was held on May 9, 2018 at the Bradley Beach Municipal Complex after roll was called. In attendance was: Charles A. Quixley, Mark Balzarano, Marc Rosenthal, Suzanne Klarewicz, Anthony DiMaio, and Salvatore Galassetti

1. Called to order at 7 p.m.
2. Electric bills \$20.33, \$20.32, \$217.02 total \$257.67. Motion to pay bills by Mark Rosenthal, Suzanne Klarewicz seconded the motion, the motion carried.
3. No caucus available, will buy flowers, but will cost more for 46 barrels with 5 plants at least, 200 flowers, 40 centers in flower beds.
4. Will need concrete paint for concrete flower beds, and two gallons of white paint for bridge and two gallons of red for the top of the railing.
5. Leo, new worker, has worked for part days at gazebo and worked with removal of weeds around the lake and removal of broken limbs, cost is slightly more at \$12 per hour.
6. Need for new P / w BB help for sand removal as blowers and machine cut down hours of hand removal and walkway pavers and our signed pavers. Note embankment has slightly shifted downward into Lake at outfall. Must keep eye on it.
7. Olga Blum retired after 25 years due to health issues. She has consistently served as a volunteer member and secretary. I'm advised Anthony DiMaio has offered to volunteer for the Lake Commission and Secretary. I'm also advised that John Bower has also resigned from the Lake Commission. Marine Park has taken a new direction in the past 2 weeks.
8. Will be making an open path to the drain wheels as grass has filled in the path, will undertake starting painting the walk bridge and will need volunteers wishing to help with this task.
9. Mark Balzarano has info on a new air filtration for the East End of the lake. Must check on the electric outlet cost and install one, replaced air filter for \$2,650, and a new light for \$4,657, totaling \$7,500, motion by Mark Rosenthal and Mark Balzarano seconded the motion, motion carried.
10. Flags will be put up for Memorial Day. May need to purchase PW and New Jersey flag; already have the American flag.
11. Need commitment from Bradley Beach PW to water flowers like last year as well as some volunteers. Welcome Anthony DiMaio as new member. Geese police thank the volunteers for the egg checking and have discussed geese police involvement. Motion to close Mark Rosenthal, second Suzanne Klarewicz.
