The 2016 Fire District Budget reflects an overall increase of less than ½ of 1% in total appropriations versus 2015. The 2016 budget eliminates the appropriation for a new Fire Chief vehicle which was purchased in 2015. The 2016 budget reflects a \$6,000 increase, or 23%, in the line item for professional services. This is in anticipation of architectural services for the possibility of capital improvements to the Olin Street firehouse.
- 2. Complete a brief statement on the impact the proposed Annual Budget will have on the Amount to be Raised by Taxation to support the district budget and on the Restricted and Unrestricted Fund Balance(s). The 2016 proposed budget contains a 0.6% increase in the Amount to be Raised by Taxation versus 2015. The amount to be raised by taxation is influenced by nominal increases in several line items offset by the elimination of an appropriation for a Fire Chief vehicle. There is no change in the use of unrestricted fund balance in the 2016 budget versus 2015.

The statement must explain reasons for exceeding the Levy Cap and identify the appropriations that caused the Fire District to exceed the Levy Cap, and how they are being addressed by a referendum. The proposed 2016 budget is \$14,301 below the maximum allowable amount to be raised by taxation as provided by the Property Tax Cap Levy.
